THE TRADITION

Football was introduced to Covington in 1904 by James Bartmess, a graduate of that same year. Although the odds against its survival were many, the sport was continued for six years and disbanded in 1910.

The present day football movement was started in 1946 and can be credited to many community members who promoted the sport in order to solicit funds to outfit a team. The Buccs played their first season in 1947 under coach Burr Simpson and recorded a 2-6 record.

Since that first season of modern foot-
ball, Covington has recorded four per-
fect seasons in 1952, 1960, 1968 and
1973. One other team finished without
a loss as the 1951 team had a record
of 7-0-1.

Two Covington teams earned recogni-
tion as State Champions as the 1960
team was awarded the title by the Asso-
ciated Press and the 1973 team was
selected by the U.P.I. The 1979 Bucca-
neers captured a state runner-up trophy
as well.

Since the inception of the play-off
system, 14 Covington teams have made
play-off appearances, including ten in
the past eleven years.
